Through your donations towards emergency responses your support allowed ADRA to respond: When hurricane Beryl swept across the Caribbean, destroying agriculture, livestock and infrastructure, your gifts provided vital humanitarian support.

When devastating floods hit Brazil, ADRA provided shelter support, meals, clothing and hygiene kits.

In Ukraine, where conflict continues to bring hardship, your generosity brought food aid to those struggling to survive.

In Gaza, essential resources remain critically scarce, with a 94% reduction in water availability and 45% of the population facing emergency levels of food insecurity. In response ADRA provided critical aid, hot meals and food packages to internally displaced people.

Sixty-five-year-old Abed Odeh has experienced immense loss as a result of the conflict, including the death of three grandchildren. He has been forced to flee his home eight times, seeking refuge in severely overcrowded shelters and unable to afford basic necessities such as food. In these dire circumstances, ADRA's support has provided a vital source of relief. "I am deeply grateful for these hot meals," Abed says. "Without them, I don't know how we would have survived."

When we serve and give together, we reflect God's heart for those who are suffering. As Proverbs 19:17 reminds us: "Whoever is kind to the poor lends to the Lord, and He will reward them for what they have done." Thank you for your compassion and support.
