# ADRA Europe 2025 ART Contest Update





## Winner of the 5–9 age group Pancharat Carawukh - Thailand

**Drawing: Humanity on the moove (543 votes)**

It is a poignant artwork that delves into compassion and the refugee experience. Using colored pencils two figures walking hand-in-hand, symbolizing solidarity. Surrounding them are scenes of kindness, like food distribution and joyful children, contrasted with elements of destruction that reflect the harsh realities of displacement. A pink banner reading "Welcome We Care" invites compassion, emphasizing the need for empathy and community support in creating safe environments for refugees.



## Winner of the 10–14 age group Nasmina Ahmad - Azerbaijan

**Gouache: “Everything behind” (662 votes)**

My art work depicts refugees who forced to leave their “Life” and go to unknown dark direction. War is cold, that’s why I chose mainly cold colors for my work. I painted house on back a little boy symbolically conveying the message that “ no matter where we go, our home, our house, our life are always with us”. Also I painted dark clouds on the head of refugees to emphasize their trouble. Bullets are raining and hearts are bleeding. A Life is gray in a war.







## Winner of the 15–18 age group Bomine Kim - South Korea

**Drawing - pencil, watercolor on paper: “Saying Goodbye ” (349 votes)**

Preparing for this competition, I started researching about the war between Ukraine and Russia. Large number of kids in Ukraine are migrating to other countries and farewelling their homes at a young age. I found data that children make up half of all refugees from the war in Ukraine, according to UNICEF and UNHCR. In this artwork, I focused on expressing the depressing situations and emotions the child is facing. I hope the migrating children will one day get back to their homes.

## Winner of the 19–25 age group Sedra Hamami - Syria

Drawing, painting: “Wounds That Don’t Bleed”  
(384 votes)


Reflects displacement breathing yet never truly feeling at home. My artwork is inspired not only by my own experiences with war but also by the silent struggles of many others who have lived through the same pain. The scars of conflict remain, shaping identities and memories. Like fish in a glass tank, these figures exist but do not belong. The war may have ended, yet its echoes live on in countless untold stories.

And when the war is over — who will erase the memories and the pain we carry within?

# Enhanced Rural AI (TERAI) Project in Nepal

# TERAI PROJECT - Nepal



- The Enhanced Rural AI (TERAI) Project is for smallholder Dairy Farmers in Nepal.
- A 4-year project which began in 2022.
- Aims to strengthen the resilience and improve incomes of over 3,630 smallholder farmers by developing improved dairy production systems and linking to the value chain.
- This will also enhance the farmers livelihoods and increase their resilience. Allowing them to afford education, improve their savings and better able to cope with economic shocks.
- By the end of project, the aim is also to increase average number of hunger-free months among the beneficiaries by 30%.
- Addresses SDGs 1 – Poverty alleviation and 2– Zero hunger
