
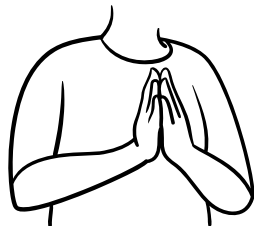



Afghanistan Earthquake – Emergency Appeal



- 6.0+ magnitude earthquake struck on Thursday August 31st 2025.
- Eastern region of Afghanistan – In 4 provinces of: Nangarhar, Kunar, Nuristan and Laghman.
- Over 2,200+ people killed (and counting)

- More than 3,600 injured (and counting)
- Approximately 500,000 people directly affected (263,000 children and 128,000 women)
- 6,782 Houses completed destroyed.





Urgent Needs

- Food and clean water
- Shelter (winterised tents etc...)
- Medical Assistance and supplies
- WASH supplies (water, sanitation and hygiene)

Jersey Breed Focused Dairy Development in Zambia (JBFDDZ)

JBFDDZ PROJECT - Zambia



- The Jersey Breed Focused Dairy Development Zambia (JBFDDZ) Project intends to help smallholder Dairy Farmers in Zambia.
- A 3-year project which began in 2022.
- Aims to strengthen and increase the resilience of 8,100 farmers in Chongwe, Chibombo and Choma Districts - and their ability to respond to shocks and stresses as a result of economic or climatic factors.
- Aim to enhance the farmers' resilience, incomes and support the development of a sustainable dairy system.
- The project will improve the farmers' productivity through improved husbandry practices and enhance knowledge and capacity in sustainable and climate-smart dairy practices
- Promote the development of an appropriate system for the delivery of sustained dairy genetic gains through improved last mile delivery.
- Addresses SDGs 1 – Poverty alleviation and 2– Zero hunger.
- Funding Partners – Jersey Overseas Aid (JOA) and the Royal Jersey Agricultural and Horticultural Society).

Training and Education of Farmers

- ✓ Best practices in care and feeding for the Jersey Breed Cows.
- ✓ Educate on what to feed and how.
- ✓ On what medicines to use (vaccines etc...)
- ✓ Illustrate how to grow certain type of grass (that goes into making their own feed).
- ✓ How to identify when they are in heat.

Training and Education of Farmers



Teach farmers how to package and store hay bales for their own consumption and also to sell. – Hay is an essential food item for cows when pasture is unavailable and affect milk production and quality.

Training and Education of Farmers

- ✓ Train on hygiene practices for storing milk and transporting it.
- ✓ How to clean the milk containers and ensure their milk is uncontaminated and remains good quality.



At Milk Collection Centre

- Where farmers sell their milk to the centre.
- The centre then buys, stores, resells locally and further afield.
- The Centres also make other products from the milk for sale such as yoghurt and curd.

Recruitment - ADRA Ambassadors and Youth Ambassadors

- Recruitment drive targeting **churches without ADRA reps.**
- Emails with resource packs being sent to church Pastors, Head Elders and Church Clerks.
- Ambassador landing page to be updated on website.



All churches in the BUC should have an ADRA Ambassador and / or an ADRA Youth Ambassador !
